We are also pleased to welcome to the stage **Lee Harvey-Heath** who is an adult living with FASD. Lee will be joined by an adoptive parent who is caring for a child who is suspected to be on the spectrum.

Dr Patricia Jackson, consultant paediatrician and **Dr Chris Steer**, consultant paediatrician in Fife, who have been involved in the development of the FASD diagnostic pathway in Scotland.

Professor Moria Plant, is Emeritus Professor of Alcohol Studies at the University of the West of England in Bristol, UK and Adjunct Professor at Curtin University in Perth, Australia. Professor Plant will be talking about behavioural aspects by age, and the physical aspects where young people with FASD may be much more likely to experience problems both physically and psychologically.

Workshop sessions will be facilitated by Eileen Calder from FASD Scotland, Sleep Scotland, Dr Mukherjee and Dr Sarah Brown, Lee Harvey-Heath, Rena Philips from PACS with Susannah MacKay, a foster and adoptive parent, Paula McPhail, an adoptive mother and her daughter Maryelen McPhail.
